Anti-Social Behaviour

A relatively quiet month for school holiday break.

We continue to receive complaints about anti-social driving and noise nuisance from a car known to us in the shooting fields area. We have spoken to the driver on several occasions and passed the information we have received to the police. We would like to encourage residents in the area to report such nuisance on the operation crackdown website. Despite increasing our patrols and static monitoring of the area we have been unable to witness such incidents ourselves.

We have had occasion to move a group of noisy youths from the Chandlers Way Playpark late one weekday evening.

We continue to carry out patrols and static monitoring of the memorial playing field at weekends and have deterred several groups of youths from gathering there with the intention of drinking alcohol.

We also have carried out early morning dog patrols on a weekly basis at different days of the week during the summer break, engaging especially with young people to ensure they have dog poo bags.

On two occasions we had to hand out bags to young people who were not carrying any.

We have had a report from a resident in Alfred close regarding damage done to a vehicle overnight. The incident has been reported to Police.

We also assisted with the two youth events that took place in Fletchers Croft and Upper Beeding recreation ground.
