Anti-Social Behaviour

We have continued with our push of operation crackdown and updated the police with several vehicle registration numbers of cars that we have seen driving in an anti social manner. We would like to encourage residents to report any incidents of this manner on the operation crackdown website.

We have been contacted regarding damage done to a polytunnel at the allotments, and more recently shed doors being removed. Although nothing has been stolen we have stepped up patrols and will monitor the area.

On a Friday night shift at 23:00 we dispersed a large group of male youths who had decided to start a game of football in the car park at fletchers croft. The group are known to us.

We had a call from a resident regarding a group of youths casing noise nuisance at the playpark in abbey road. We attended and moved the group on.

We are concerned about a male street drinker who regularly uses the memorial playing field. We have received calls from residents about his behaviour, in some instances he is urinating and casing alarm to other users. We have spoken to him and we are monitoring him on a regular basis. We have also passed this information onto the police.

Community

We have linked up with councillor Gill Muncey and PCSO Tom Slaughter regarding a dog fouling campaign. We have been handing out leaflets whilst on early morning dog patrols to raise awareness and attempt to gain volunteers to assist throughout the campaign. The project will last for two weeks and will include a day off action.

We have begun sessions with our new junior wardens at Steyning Primary School. They are working on dog fouling signs that will be used on the day of action. We are also keen to get them involved on the day itself.
