



Steyping Council Meeting

February - March 2014

On Monday 10/02/14 I helped search for a man who had suffered a serious knife wound after self harming. The male was found near Steyping Round Hill and taken to hospital where he remained in a stable condition.

I visited the Dingemans Centre on 26/02/14 and spoke with guests and residents. Information was given regarding crime prevention advice, home security and how to avoid becoming a victim of fraud.

I visited a man who has been scammed out of nearly £8000, the victim had invested into a fraudulent investment scam that was very convincing. Sussex police are investigating this incident and are urging members of the public to remain cautious when sending money to unknown accounts.

Courier fraud offences have only recently begun to occur within West Sussex; however this is both a regional and national issue. Sussex police are working alongside banks to raise awareness and keep staff vigilant. Please remember that the emergency services will never ask for private or confidential information over the phone. If you are ever in doubt over the authenticity of the phone call please visit your closest police station.

Unfortunately a house on Roman Road Steyping was broken into between Sunday 16/02/14 – Wednesday 19/02/14. The point of entry was through an open bathroom window on the ground floor, nothing was taken during the break in. Please contact me if you would like any crime prevention or home security advice.
