Monthly Report – July 2017

On two consecutive Friday evenings in July we had cause to intervene and confiscate alcohol from groups of young people from the orchard area of the Memorial Playing Field.

On a Saturday evening we intervened and gave words of advice to a group of young males who were drinking cans of beer in the bus shelter at the junction of Goring road. They were shouting and screaming and drawing attention to themselves, we ensured they cleared away their empty cans and other items of litter before the bus arrived.

We witnessed an adult male cycling with his dog on a lead down Sheep Pen Lane, both dog and cyclist negotiated the roundabout on the wrong side, past Spring Wells heading up towards Clays Hill and was causing alarm to oncoming motorists. We stopped the individual as he was causing a danger to himself and other road users and ensured he walked his bike and dog on the pavement.
