Neighbourhood Wardens Report September 2017 to date.

### Anti-Social Behaviour and Crime

We are still carrying out patrols in the Charlton Barn area as we have had another report that young people are climbing the scaffolding around one of the barns that it is structurally unsafe.

We have received e report from a resident of Charlton Street concerning a young boy riding a bicycle in a reckless and dangerous fashion.

We had cause to caution a man who was riding a cycle, meandering across Steyping High Street whilst holding a bottle of beer in his hand. We have passed on his details to the Anti - Social Behaviour Team.

We have had reports from Residents at Dingemans concerning nuisance behaviour at the Bus Shelter and have stepped up patrols of the area accordingly.

Late on a Friday evening a 15yr old boy was assaulted in the Car Park of the Memorial Playing Fields. We arrived at the scene where a Police Car passing through the High Street was flagged down by a member of the public. A 19yr old man was arrested and we were able to positively identify the perpetrator who is known to us. The perpetrator allegedly broke a bottle on the young boys head. Police took witness statements from young people present.

We have now completed our Fixed Penalty Notice Training regarding the new Public Space Protection legislation that will be ratified by Horsham District Council Members in November. The Community Safety Manager Greg Charman will be writing to the Parish Councils following this to explain the protocols and extent of the new powers available to us.

We had reason to caution a young man who was continually driving in circles around the Fletchers Croft Car Park. We took his registration details and recorded them on The Operation Crackdown Website.
