Wardens' Monthly Report December 2014

Anti-Social Behaviour

We have had reports from a resident of a blue Subaru driving at speed in the Shooting Fields area and advised the caller to report the two incidents on the Operation Crackdown Website. We have had a similar report regarding a Blue Vauxhall Corsa driven by a young person known to us. The latter vehicle was involved in a collision from which the driver failed to stop. Unbeknown to him the owner of the vehicle was an off duty police officer who immediately summoned a Police traffic Unit who were able to pursue and detain the driver. A small amount of cannabis was found in the vehicle and a second warning issued.

The run up to Christmas saw a variety of cold callers operating across the three parishes and we had cause to ask for identification from three different groups. We ensured that we maintained a consistent presence during the area throughout the period.

We had occasion to confiscate alcohol from one underage young person gathering in the play park in Fletchers Croft. We moved the group on and continued to monitor the area.

On the 17th December, whilst carrying out a routine patrol of the Memorial Play park we cleared some beer bottles and other general litter from the wooded area adjacent to the Rublees allotments. We also discovered an empty cannabis bag adjacent to the perimeter of the Swing Park.

Following complaints from two residents in St Cuthmans Rd regarding noise nuisance from neighbours we have advised that they monitor and report via incident report forms and make the Registered Landlord aware
