Neighbourhood Wardens Report Dec 2015 to date.

Anti-Social Behaviour and Crime

On a joint patrol with PCSO Clough we came across two young males smoking cannabis in a car in Fletchers Croft. A unit was called to the scene, drugs were seized and a cannabis warning was issued.

On patrol in Fletchers Croft we intervened with a group and confiscated alcohol, all of the individuals were under the age of 18. We also had a large group of youths with cars, being rowdy and causing a general nuisance. We have formally recorded this incident, noted the names and registrations of the individuals involved and will liaise with the Anti-Social Behaviour team should there be any repeat offences.

A Drugs warrant was executed by Police at an address in Toomey Road. A large quantity of cannabis resin was seized along with £1200 cash and large amount of drugs paraphernalia. A 41 year old man was arrested.

Ten people have been recently sentenced as part of a network of criminals committing fraud offences across Surrey and Sussex which included victims from Steypning and Upper Beeding. We continue to patrol, respond to calls and check credentials of individuals going from door to door. Any suspicious activity will be reported to the Neighbourhood Policing Team. We would like to encourage residents to contact ourselves should they have any concerns regarding cold callers in the area.

There have been a number of thefts in Steypning this month including a Mountain bike stolen from a garage in Goring Road along with a lawn mower and some tools.

A Property in Castle Way Steypning was broken into, access was gained by removing a window. A Large amount of jewellery stolen.

Community.

We attended and patrolled the Steypning High Street late night shopping event. The event was well attended and we did not encounter any anti-social behaviour. There was a lost child reported to us who was soon reunited with his parents.

We continue to support Vintage Years and to run the Thursday afternoon social club at the Dingemans Centre.
