Crime and Anti-Social Behaviour

On the 16th October a fold up bicycle was reported to have been stolen from a property in the high street.

On Friday 23 October there was criminal damage caused to a vehicle in the Memorial Playing Field Car Park. Police were called and attended and a fixed penalty was given to a young male who admitted responsibility.

A Young male from Steyping has been issued with a PIN (Police Information Notice) regarding allegations of Harassment towards two younger persons.

On Thurs 22 October we carried out a quick search of the Fletchers Croft Play park following reports from two residents that they believed two males, known to us ,had been smoking cannabis in the area. We discovered one discarded cannabis bag. We have passed this information onto the police.

Sussex Police have launched an initiative called Operation Magpie which tackles Home break-ins and burglary of dwelling. The Campaign will run across Sussex until the 10 November and includes spreading the word through both social and traditional media to highlight home security advice.

P.C.S.O.'s, partner agencies and volunteers, including Neighbourhood Watch will be organising targeted activities in Hotspots, talking to residents and handing out leaflets.
