Anti-social Behaviour

On patrol on grammar school grounds we had to intervene in a physical fight that had broken out between a small group of boys. We have spoken to the parents of the individuals.

Subject to previous calls from a resident regarding some low level anti-social behaviour, we have continued with patrols in the twittens near the school and surrounding areas, mainly breech close.

Dog fouling has been highlighted as an increasing issue this month. We've had details from a few residents in the area and we have increased our patrols in response.

We continue to receive reports regarding cold callers across the three parishes, we would like to remind residents to remain vigilant and call any suspect behaviour into the police or ourselves.
